Our Activities

Rescue and Fostering

While AFL is not a rescue organization and does not have shelter facilities, we have provided emergency assistance to animals in need within our community. AFL now has a presence on Petfinder.com and has successfully fostered and placed several pets.

Community Outreach and Education

AFL has a comprehensive website which provides links to many local animal resources. We also produce a quarterly newsletter filled with animal success stories, fun facts, and helpful information. AFL has also partnered with the Lansdowne Public Library, donating animal-related books and setting up a display each year in the library foyer.

Paws for Kindness Day

Paws for Kindness Day is our major, annual event held in May. It was created by AFL as a way to bring attention and awareness to animal issues affecting Lansdowne — both its four-legged and two-legged residents — and to raise money for Animal Friends of Lansdowne to achieve its goals.

AFL Dog Walk

Animal Friends' dog walk fundraiser and is held in October each year. Registrants receive an AFL t-shirt and dog bandana, as well as a beautiful walk around Lansdowne with fellow dog-lovers.
