

Attention Lansdowne Cat Owners!

The Borough of Lansdowne, Animal Friends of Lansdowne and The Spayed Club are teaming up to provide a low-cost spay/neuter clinic for Lansdowne cats.

*Does your male cat spray urine around your home or keep fighting with other cats?
Does your female cat keep crying all night or having kittens?
We can help reduce or stop this behavior!*

**Have your cat “fixed” for only \$40 (\$200+ value)
on Thursday, April 22nd
\$40 CASH is required at time of morning drop-off.**

Your cat will be spayed (for females) or neutered (for males) and given distemper and rabies shots at The Spayed Club Clinic in Sharon Hill, PA by licensed veterinarian Dr. Sally Alexander.

A volunteer will transport your cat(s) between Lansdowne and the Clinic.

Note: You must pre-register to participate in this clinic.

To pre-register, call (484)540-8436. Leave your name, phone number, and mention that you are with the Lansdowne transport clinic. Speak clearly and slowly so we can hear your information. A volunteer will return your call to confirm your reservation and give you pre-op instructions.

On the morning of April 22nd, you will drop off your cat(s) between 8 and 8:30 am at the Lansdowne Firehouse, 26 N. Highland Ave. (corner of Highland & Lacrosse).
Please park in the municipal lot adjacent to the firehouse.

You will return to the Lansdowne Firehouse between 7:00 and 7:30 p.m. that same day to pick up your cat(s).

Each cat MUST be in a separate carrier.

Place a towel or blanket in the bottom of each carrier.
